

PART 1: STUDENT DEMOGRAPHIC DATA


The demographic information presented in Part I represents all of the students living in Hereford Residential College for academic year 2018-2019.






Hereford is exceptionally diverse. One way to look at the above chart is that Hereford is 67% students of color.
















Which of the following mindfulness activities interest you and how often would you like to participate? - Body scan meditation




Which of the following mindfulness activities interest you and how often would you like to participate? - Guided relaxation meditation




Which of the following mindfulness activities interest you and how often would you like to participate? - Breathing exercises




Which of the following mindfulness activities interest you and how often would you like to participate? - Work/life balance workshop




Which of the following mindfulness activities interest you and how often would you like to participate? - Personal & professional fulfillment workshop












Which type of assertiveness training would you be interested in? – Social relationships











Which term do you use to describe your gender identity? - Selected Choice









What is your country of citizenship?


